Fieldwork Summary

Implementation

- 11 workdays, 163 volunteers, 502 hours
 - 2,350+ stems planted
- Water Sampling – 21 sites, 3 tests, 10 dates, 16 volunteers
 - public presentation planned for Mar. '11.
- Geomorphic assessment – Ph. 2 on Upper Missisquoi in progress

Outreach/Education Summary

- NPS Model – borrowed by 6 schools/ organizations
- Public forum – March '10 (Mike Winslow, “Lake Champlain – a Natural History”)
- Newsletter – Spring & Fall issues.
- River outing/clean-up – Westfield to Troy (18 volunteers, 99 hours)
- Bugworks – 13 sessions delivered in 5 schools, reaching over 200 students, 13 teachers, and 8 paraeducators.

Miscellaneous Activities

- Membership – 100 members (\$3,335 from 92 donors)
- River Rally – 1 MRBA representative and 1 Wild & Scenic rep attended
- Wild & Scenic – Hired coordinator S. Stewart. Study committee has been formed and meets monthly. 9 out of 10 communities have at least 1 representative appointed to the committee.
- River Festival – MRBA's first River Festival with live music (4 bands), portage race, beer tent, and 3 food vendors. Attendance: over 300 people. Over 25 volunteers. MRBA cleared \$3,000.

Volunteer Hours

- 2010 – almost 1,500 hours to Sept. 30
- since 1997 – over 15,000 hours
